-  **Maintenance advice:** Remove any dead or spindly branches at the end of winter. Appreciates mulching, 5cm thick, to stay fresh and help roots to establish. A regular prune to rejuvenate is beneficial, consisting of cutting the older greying stems just above large buds, at the end of winter.
