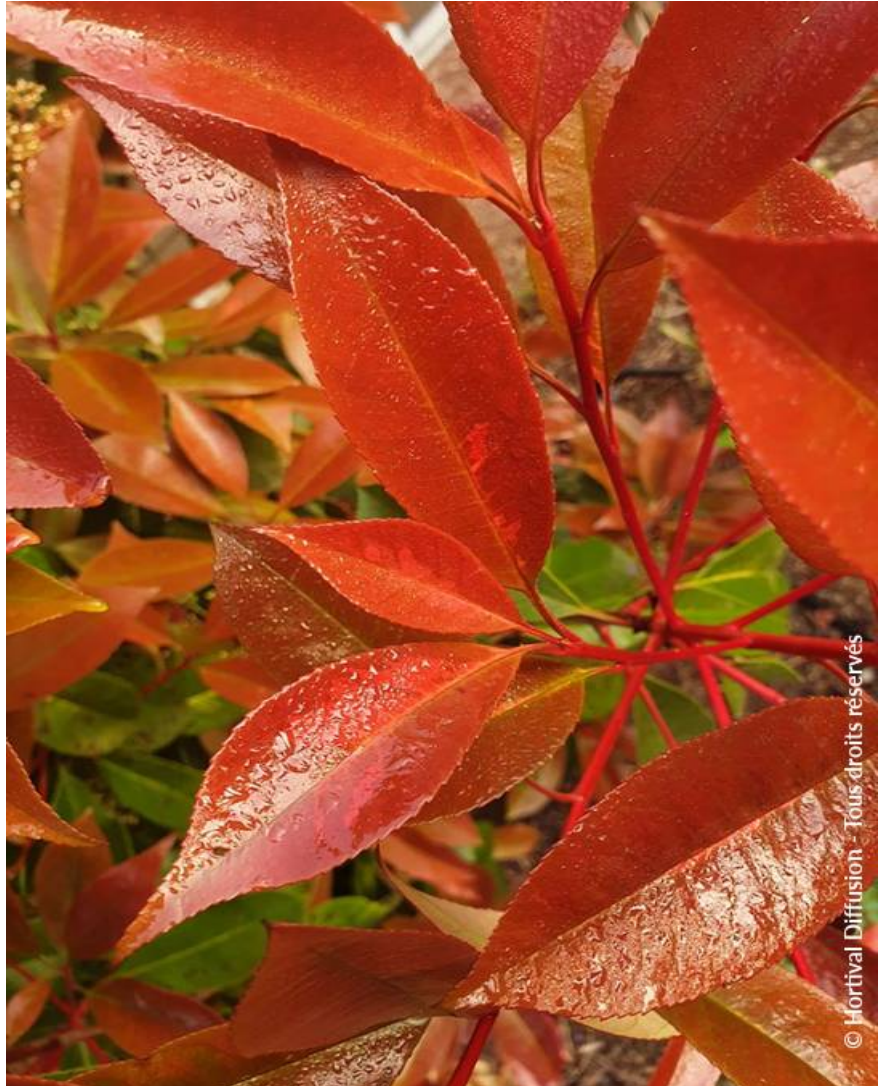

-  **Maintenance advice:** Lightly prune in early summer, to harmonize shape and thicken vegetation, encouraging the appearance of colourful new red shoots in spring.
