Female Kiwi for large fruit. For fruit plant a male or the cultivar 'Solo'.



**Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter, remove the secondary branches that have flowered and restore the plant's harmonious structure. In summer, reduce the growth of new shoots by trimming down to 2 leaves above the flower cluster.



**Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin; bred in New Zealand before 1935
