Chinese trumpet creeper, Chinese trumpet vine



Vigorous deciduous climber. Choice orange flowers.



Maintenance advice: Guide and tie the shoots until the aerial roots naturally attach to the support. At the end of winter, prune the shoots short to give it more vigour.
