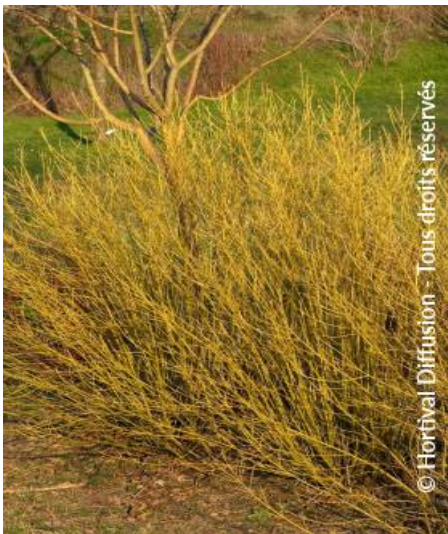


CORNUS sericea 'FLAVIRAMEA'

Deciduous shrub with bright green leaves, yellow in autumn. Excellent yellow stems in winter.



Maintenance advice: Remove old, less colourful branches at the end of winter. To ensure flowering, prune every 2-3 years.



Botanical/Horticultural origin: Introduced by the Arnold Arboretum (US) around 1890
