

# COTONEASTER franchetii

Franchet's cotoneaster



Semi-evergreen shrub with grey green small leaves. White flowers, numerous orange red fruit.



**Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter, prune slightly the tips of its shoots with shears, to limit its vegetation or keep it compact. It can tolerate severe pruning, if necessary, which removes the fruits of the year.



**Botanical/Horticultural origin:** China; discovered by Abbé Delavay (FR) 1889
