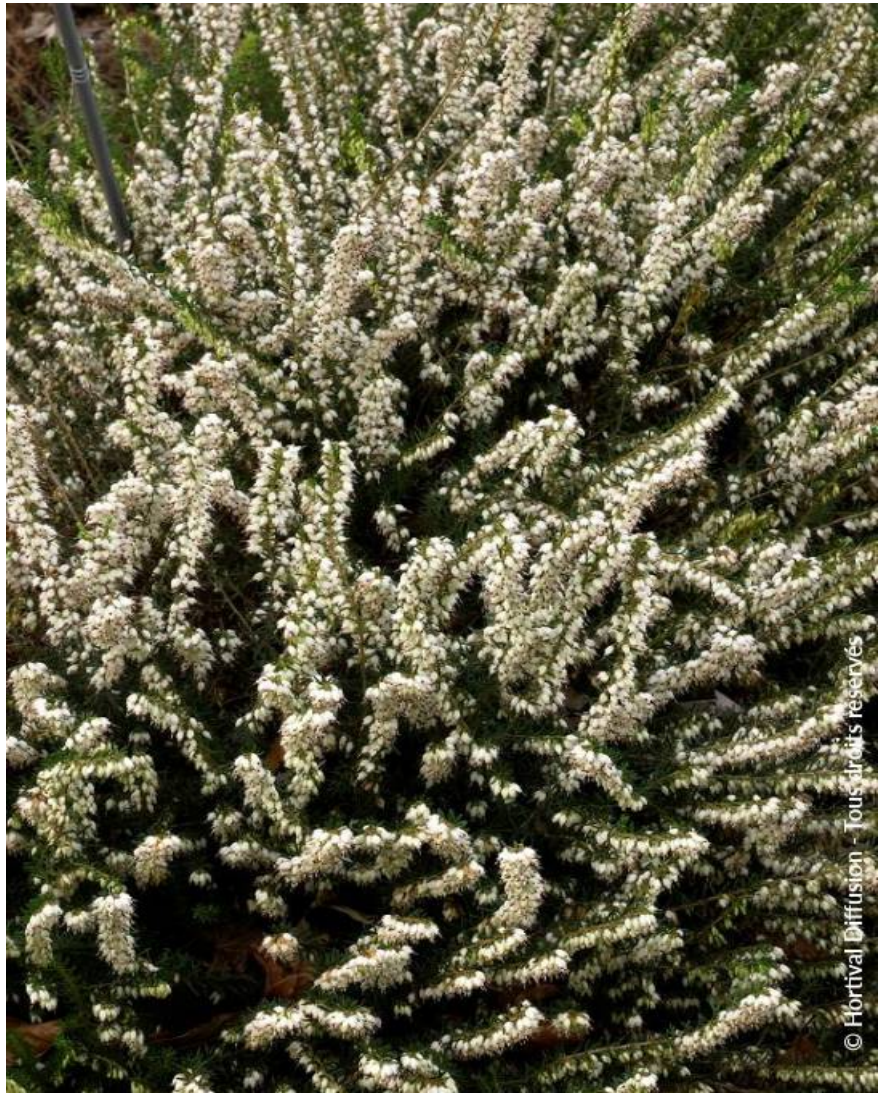
















ERICA x darleyensis 'SILBERSCHMELZE'
