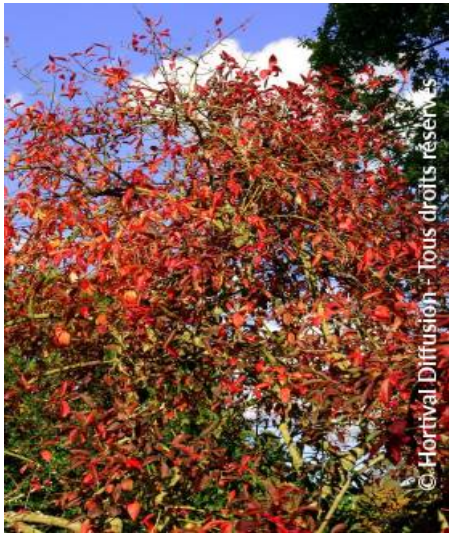
















EUONYMUS europaeus 'RED CASCADE'
