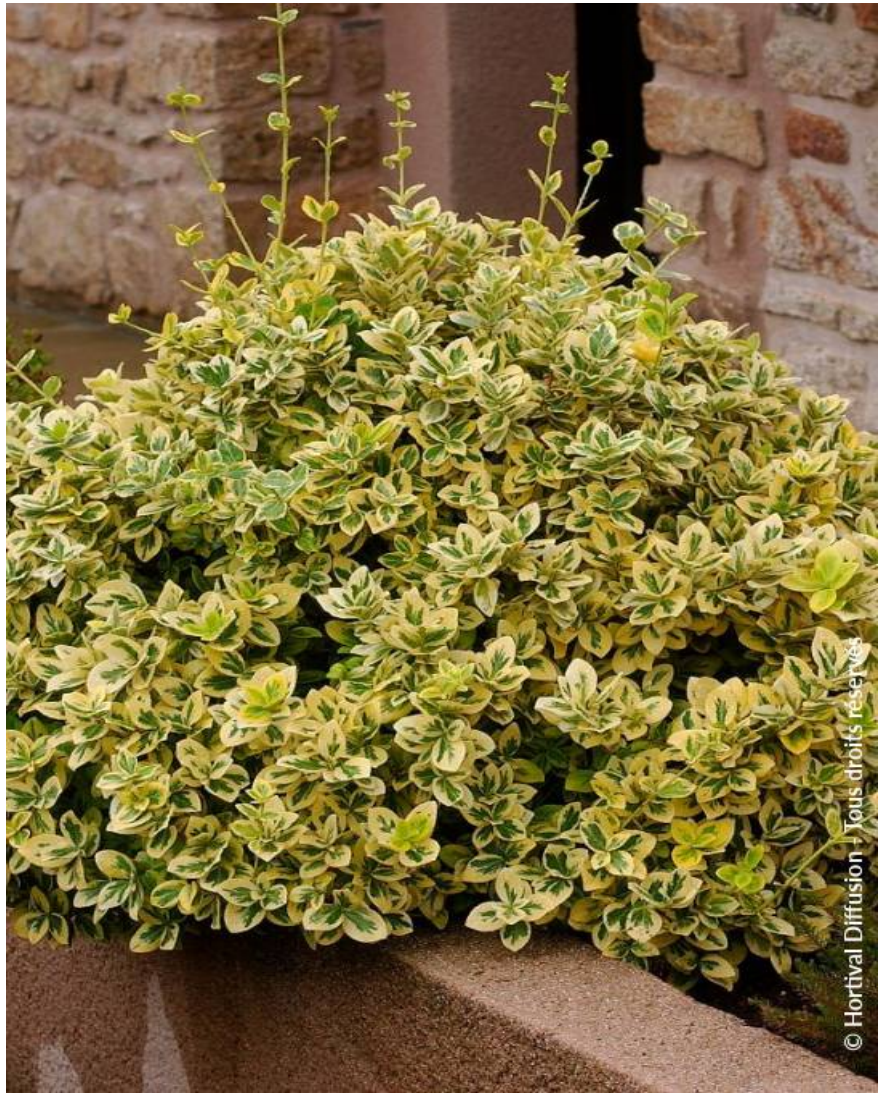

















EUONYMUS fortunei 'EMERALD 'N GOLD'
