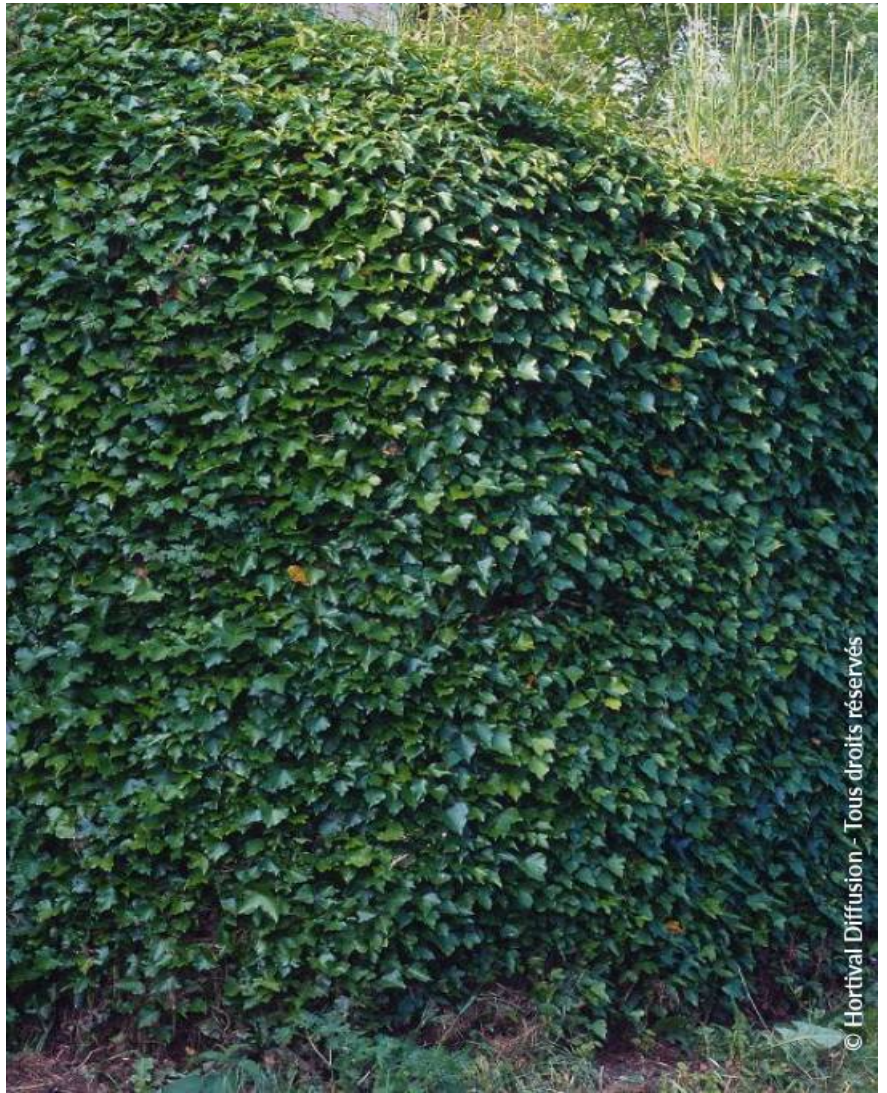


HEDERA hibernica

Irish ivy, Atlantic ivy



Evergreen climber. Small green leaves - often used as ground cover.



Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, prune it to the desired size. A second-lift pruning in June allows it to have a very regular shape if necessary.
