**Maintenance advice:** In April, remove the dead wood, the old grey stems and the withered flowers. Keep the young and vigorous stems (bearing large buds) and water regularly in dry weather.



**Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Introduced from Japan by Louis Van Houtte (B) 1843



**Use group:** Heathland plants
