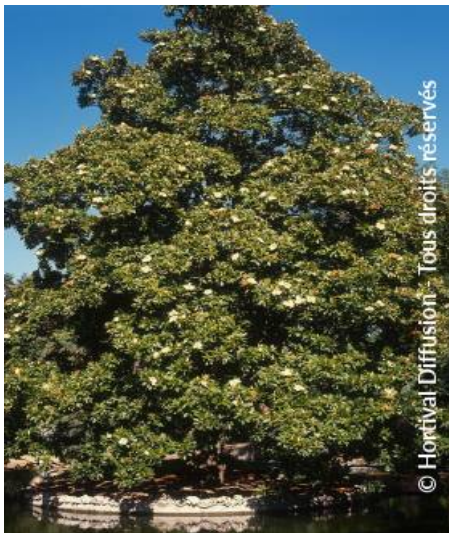
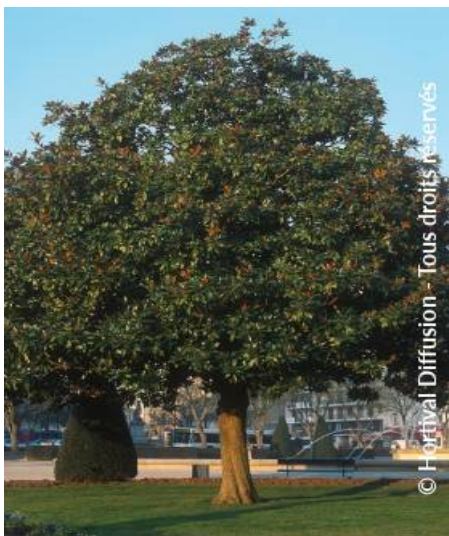


MAGNOLIA grandiflora 'GALISSONIENSIS'

-  **Maintenance advice:** Pruning is often not necessary, it can be done at the end of winter to make a very dense pyramid-shaped shrub
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Southeast United States; introduced in Nantes (FR) around 1741
-  **Use group:** Trees
-  **Height at 10 years:** 8 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 4 m
-  **Growth:** Medium
-  **Fragrance:** Yes

-  **Exposure:** Full sun
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Evergreen
-  **Shape:** conical, pyramidal
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** White
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Free standing specimen, Street tree,
