-  **Maintenance advice:** The Rhododendron appreciates cool soils: keep the soil moist with regular watering in summer. In August-September, reduce the watering to enhance the flowering in the following spring.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin; breeder Auguste Van Hecke (B) 1964
-  **Use group:** Heathland plants
-  **Height at 10 years:** 1 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1 m
-  **Growth:** Slow
