

# AZALEA japonica 'KIRIN'

Rhododendron 'Kirin'



Evergreen hybrid azalea, compact habit, small pink early flowering.



**Maintenance advice:** The Rhododendron appreciates cool soils: keep the soil moist with regular watering in summer. In August-September, reduce the watering to enhance the flowering in the following spring.
