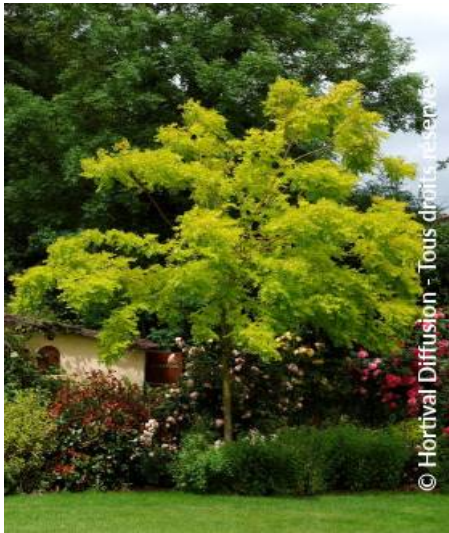

-  **Maintenance advice:** With age, it tolerates being pruned at the end of winter if necessary. The bushy shapes can be regularly rejuvenated or pruned almost to the ground level.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin; breeder W. Jansen (NL) 1935
-  **Use group:** Trees
-  **Height at 10 years:** 10 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 6 m
