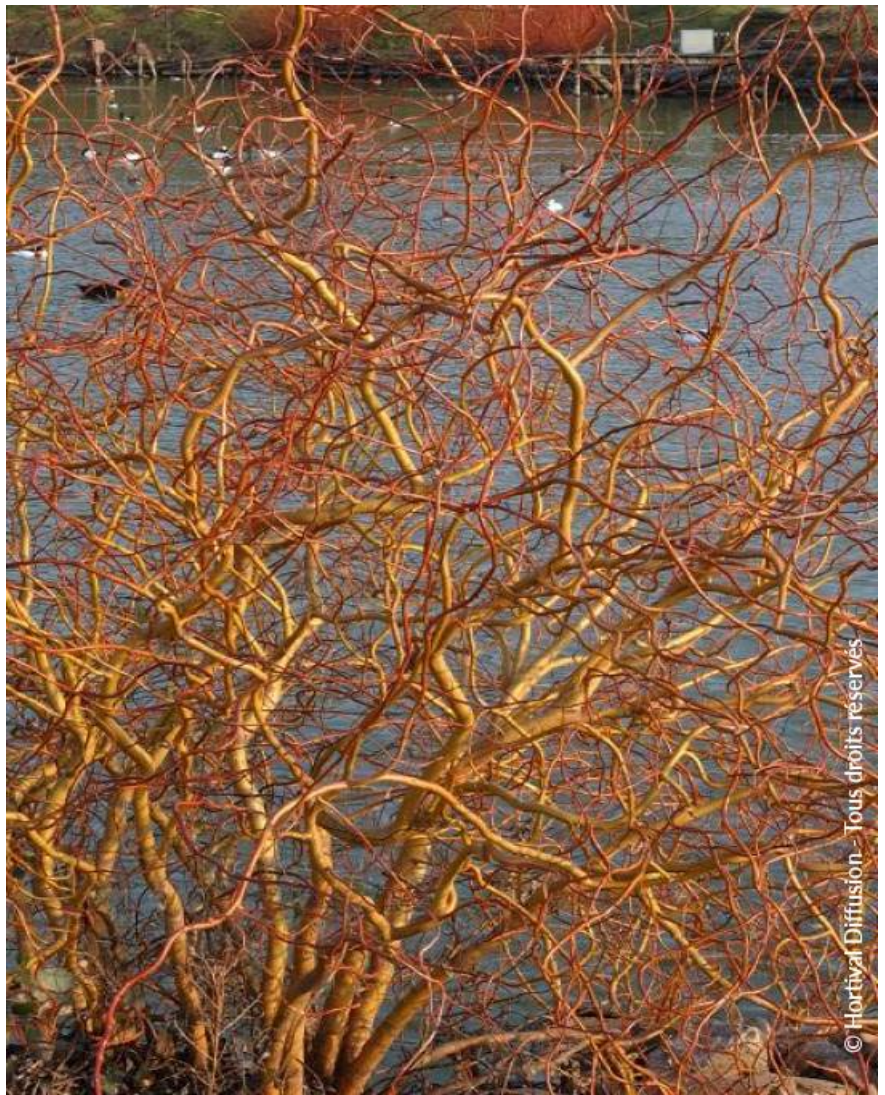
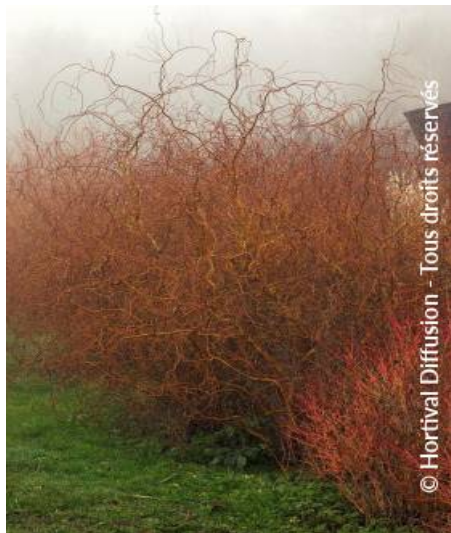

















SALIX x erythroflexuosa
