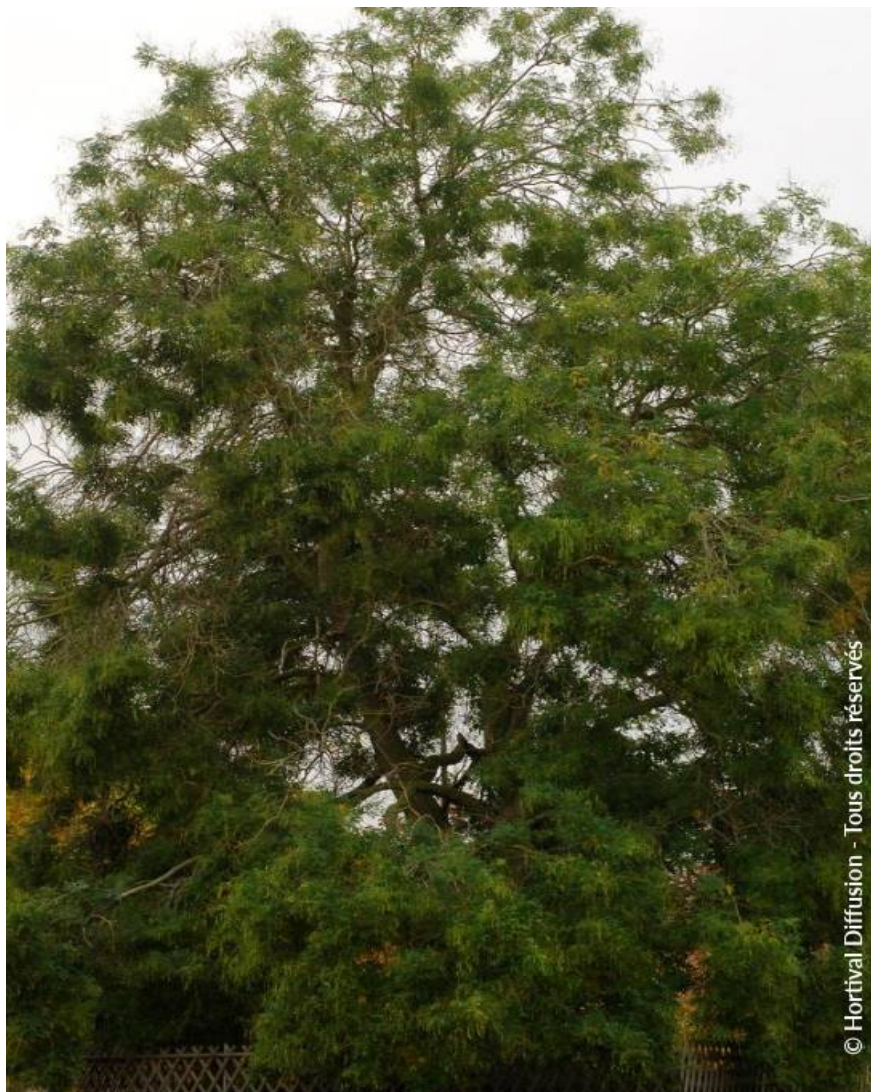


SOPHORA japonica = STYPHNOLOBIUM japonicum
