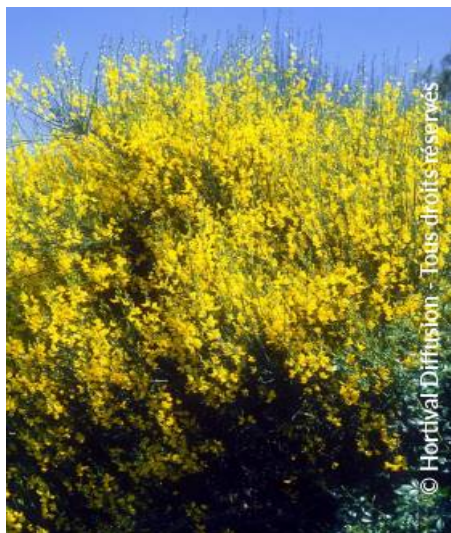


# SPARTIUM junceum

Spanish broom, rush broom



**Maintenance advice:** After the flowering, you can remove about 3/4 or 2/3 of the length of the shoots to harmonise its shape, keep it compact and remove its fruits in pods which are causing tiredness.
