-  **Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter, shorten the stems to 10-15 cm above ground surface.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin; bred in Japan long before 1963
-  **Use group:** Shrubs
-  **Height at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Growth:** Medium
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** rounded, ball, globe
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** Mixed white, pink, red
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Border, Tub/container, Free standing specimen
