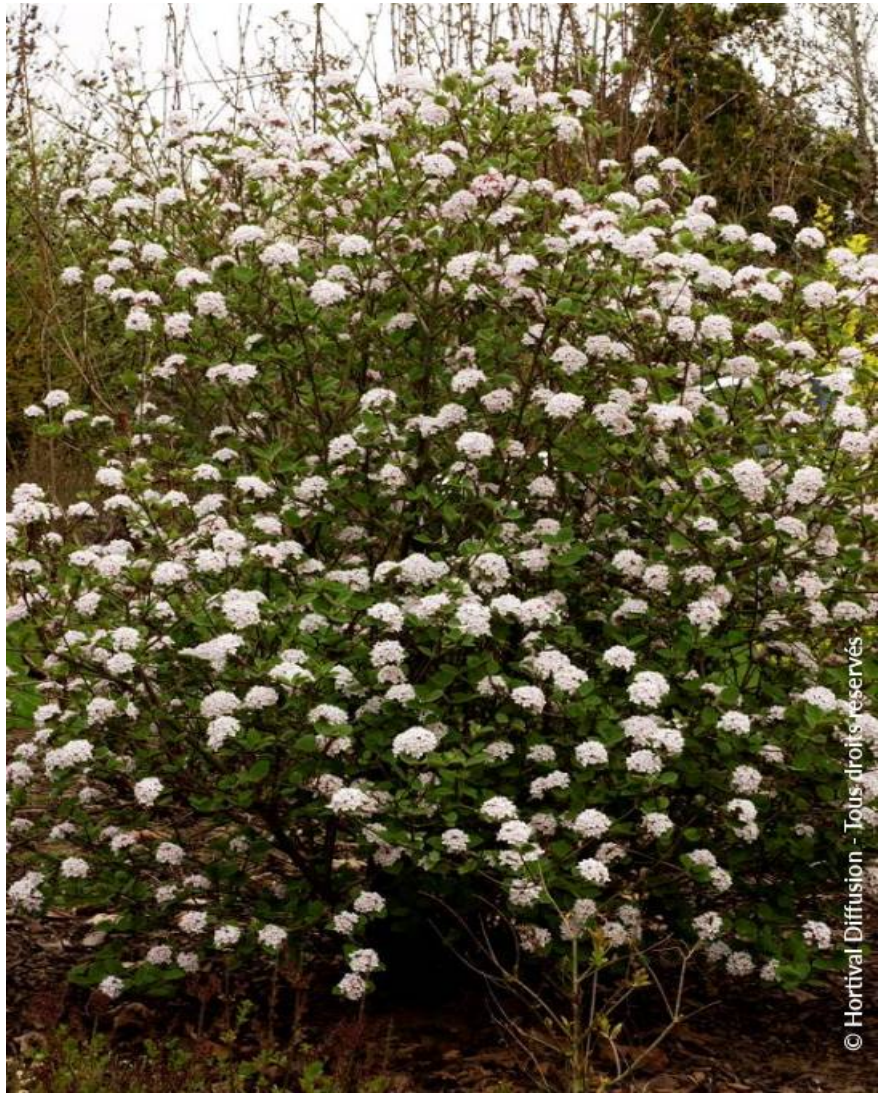
















# VIBURNUM carlesii

-  **Maintenance advice:** After the flowering, slightly prune to balance its vegetation if necessary.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Korea; Discovered by W.R. Carles (GB) 1885
-  **Use group:** Shrubs
-  **Height at 10 years:** 3 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 3 m
-  **Growth:** Medium
-  **Fragrance:** Yes

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** rounded, ball, globe
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** White/pink
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Free standing specimen, Border, Country hedge
