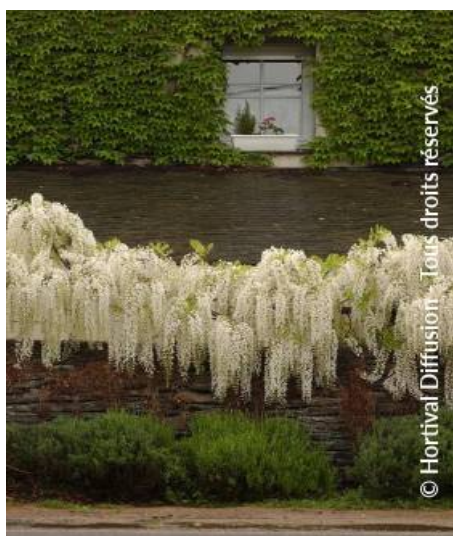


WISTERIA floribunda 'ALBA'

Hardy deciduous climber. White very long racemes of flower.



Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, prune short by keeping 4 to 5 buds per branches (they are larger and rounder than leaf buds). In autumn, shorten the shoots to about 20 cm long.
