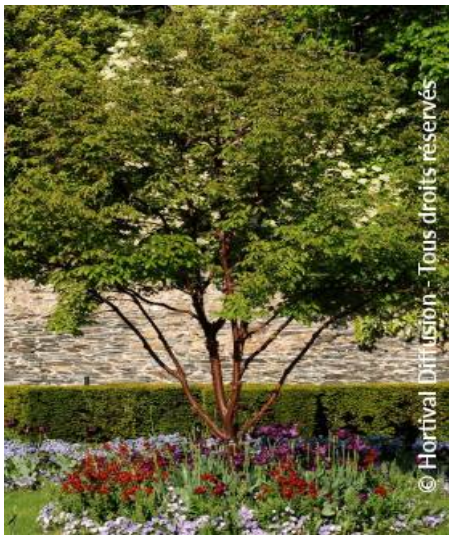

-  **Maintenance advice:** Remove dead wood and prune the scaffolds from the end of summer to the beginning of autumn, to highlight the bark.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Central China; introduced in Europe in 1901 by Ernest Wilson on behalf of Veitch Nurseries (UK)
-  **Use group:** Trees
-  **Height at 10 years:** 6 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 4 m
-  **Growth:** Medium
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** rounded, ball, globe
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** Yellow
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Free standing specimen, Border,
