-  **Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter, prune the branches that has flowered the previous year by half. Water regularly and abundantly the first year.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin; breeder Charles Billiard (FR) before 1854
-  **Use group:** Shrubs
-  **Height at 10 years:** 2 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Growth:** Medium
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** bushy
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** Pink
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Free standing specimen, Border, Country hedge
