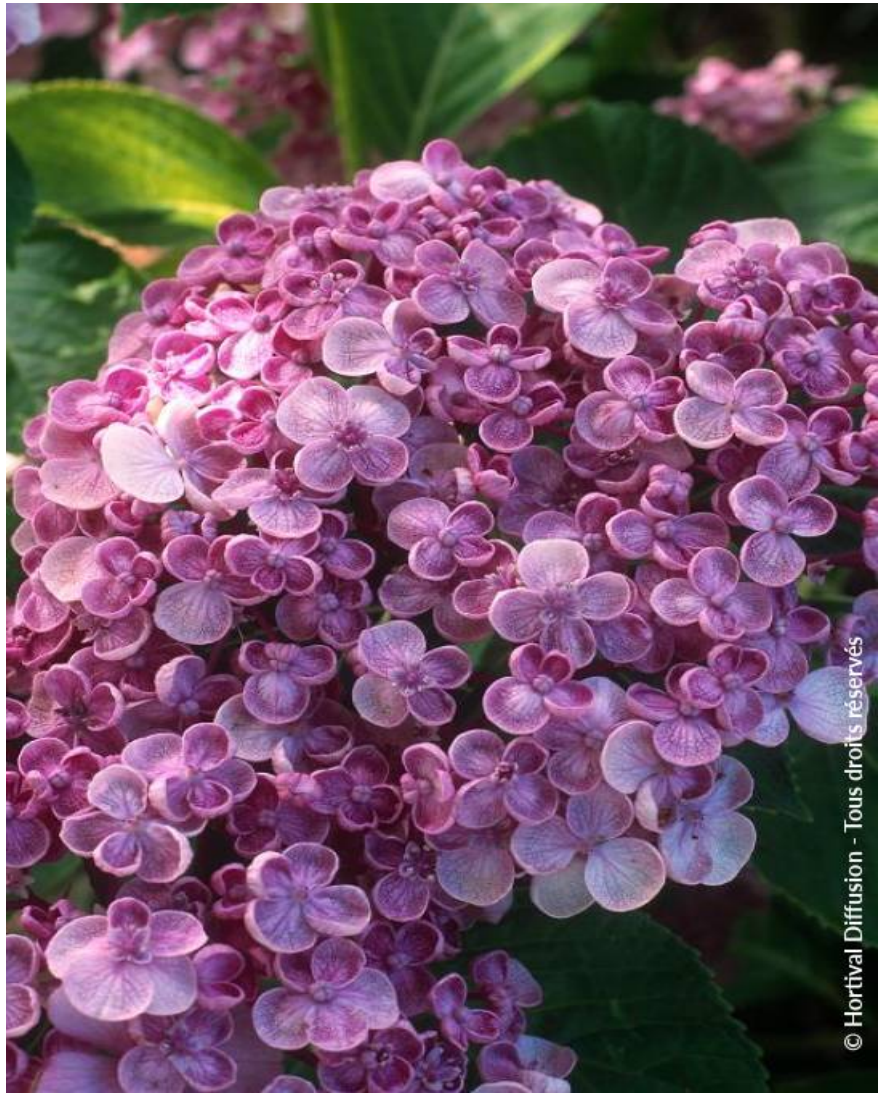

Lilac flowered Hydrangea, original flower slightly scented, strong green leaves.



**Maintenance advice:** In April, cut away any dead wood, the greying stems and wilted flowers. Keep the vigorous younger stems (with large buds). Water regularly in dry weather.



**Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Japan : introduced to Abbotsbury Garden (GB) around 1900



**Use group:** Heathland plants



**Height at 10 years:** 1,5 m



**Width at 10 years:** 1,5 m



**Growth:** Fast



**Fragrance:** Yes



**Exposure:** Shade - Half shade



**Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous



**Shape:** rounded, ball, globe



**Colour of leaves:** Green
