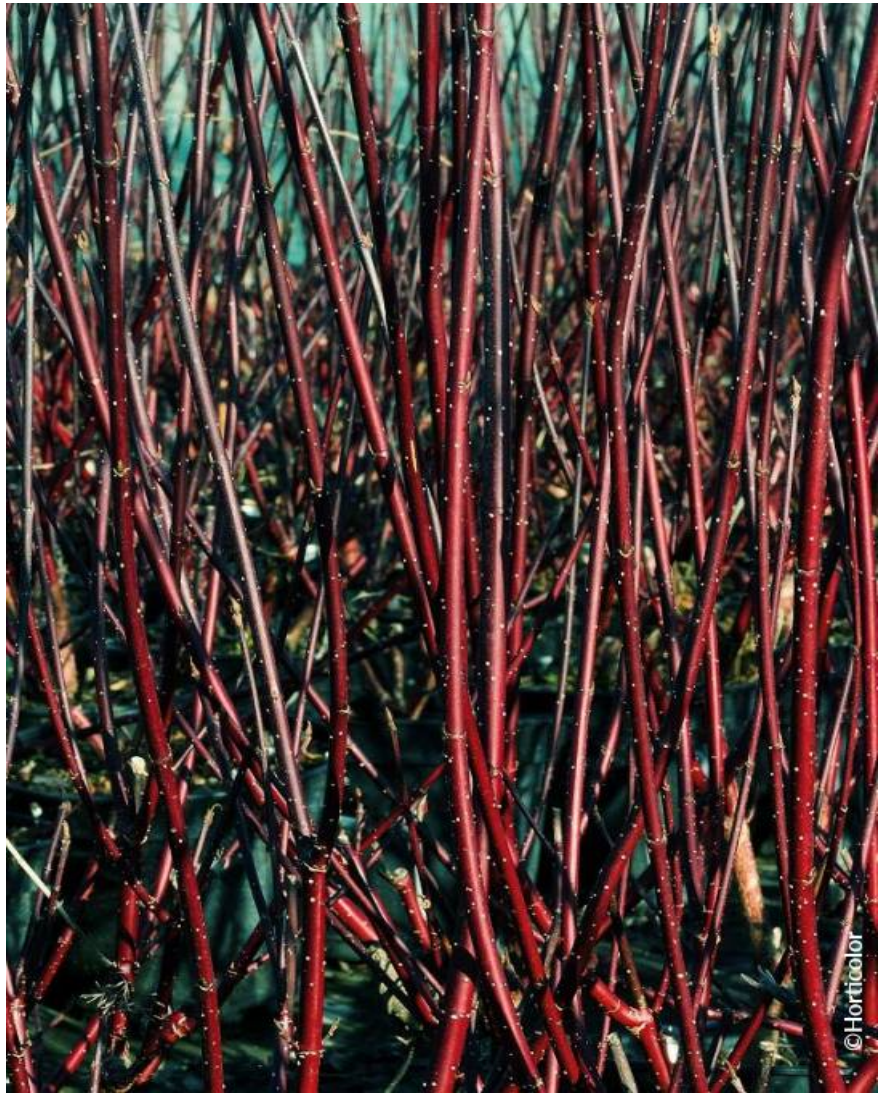


CORNUS alba 'KESSELRINGII'

Maintenance advice: A severe pruning is needed at the end of winter to get a coloured bark on the new branches. Cutting right down to the stump is possible if the tree is a few years old. To make the most of the flowers, prune every 2-3 years.
