Red-barked dogwood 'Sibirica Variegata', Variegated siberian dogwood



-  **Maintenance advice:** In winter, cut short the older branches every 2-3 years to rejuvenate and obtain new and colourful branches.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin : breeder Cornelis de Vos, Hazerswoude (NL) before 1867
-  **Use group:** Shrubs
-  **Height at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Growth:** Fast
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** bushy
-  **Colour of leaves:** Variegated green white
-  **Colour of flowers:** Cream white
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
