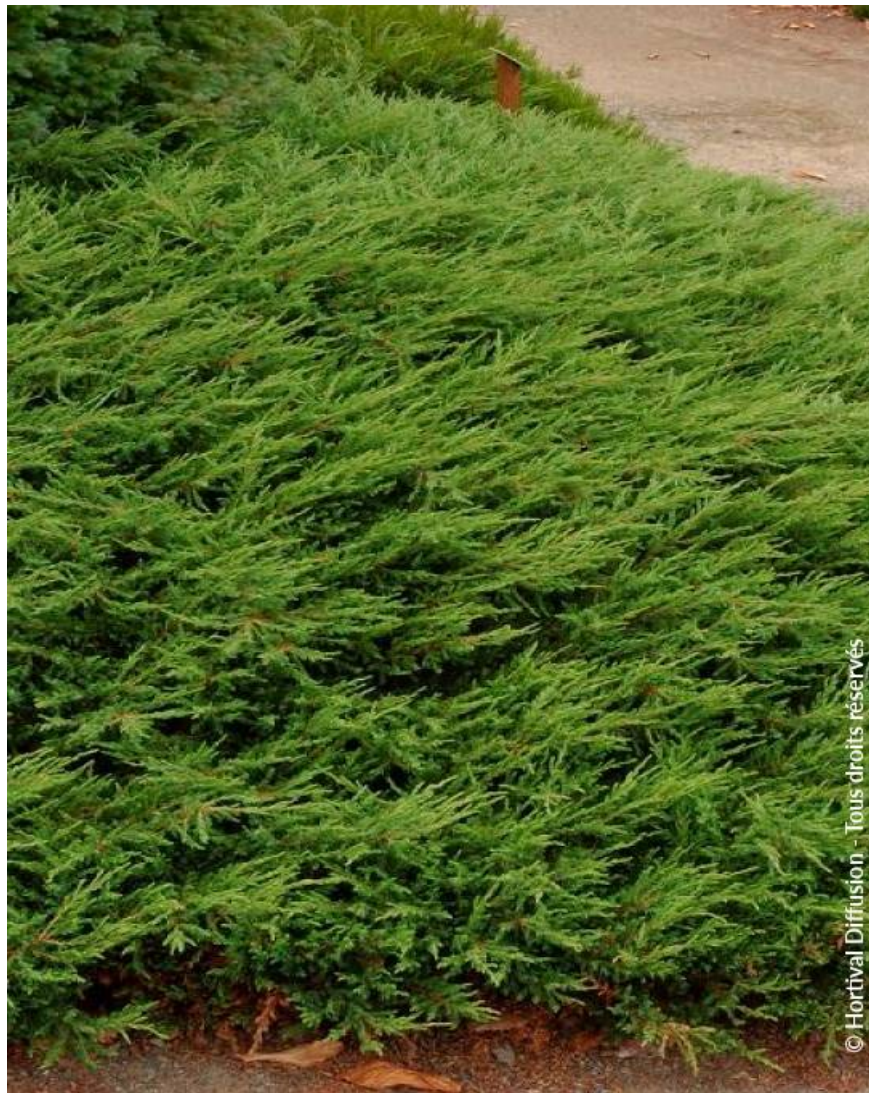
















JUNIPERUS communis 'REPANDA'

-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Found in Ireland by Maurice Prichard (GB) before 1934
-  **Use group:** Conifers
-  **Height at 10 years:** 0,5 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Growth:** Slow
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Evergreen
-  **Shape:** creeping, prostrate
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** Absent
