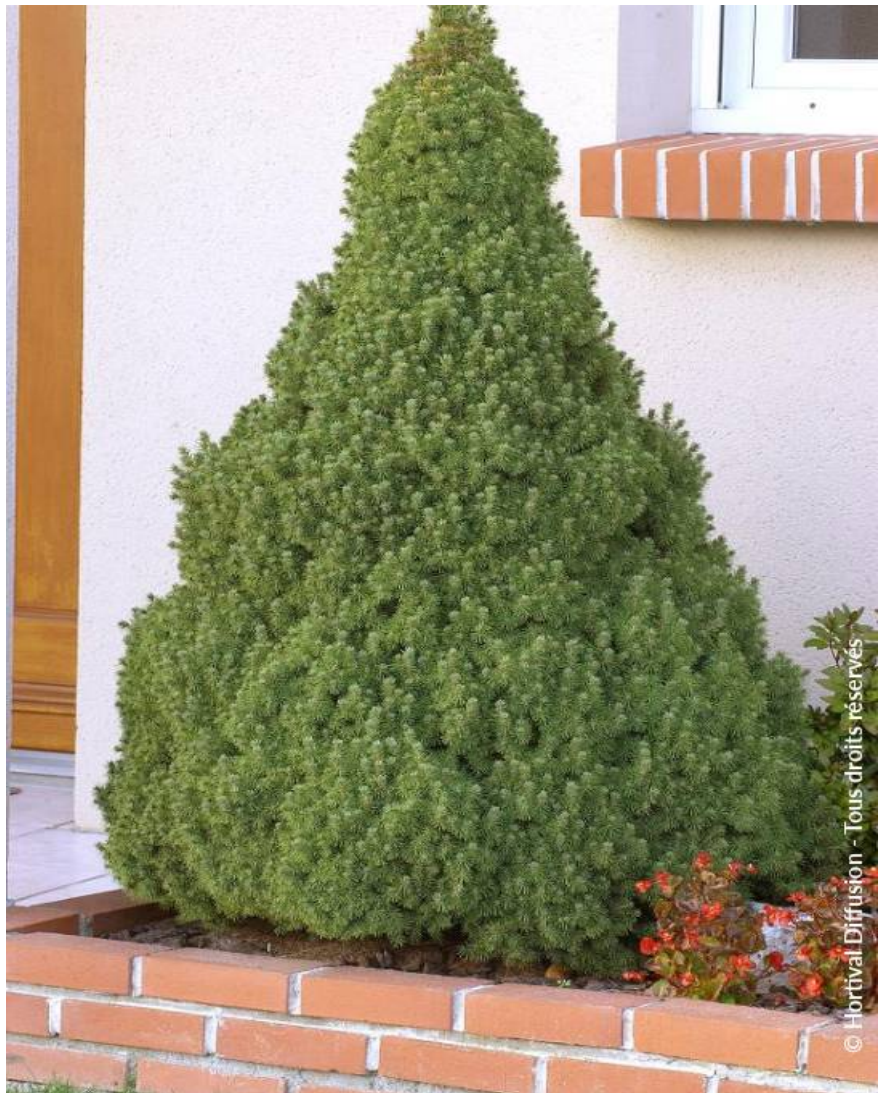
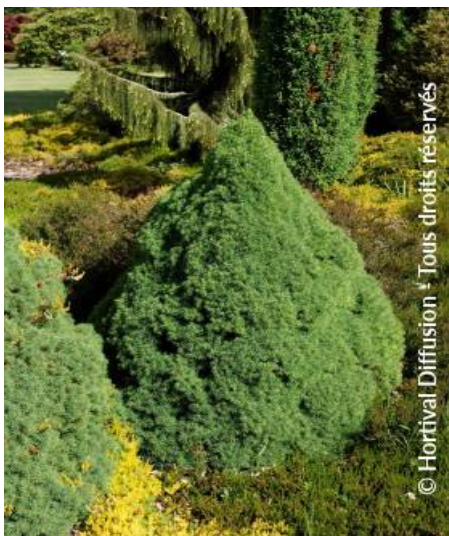
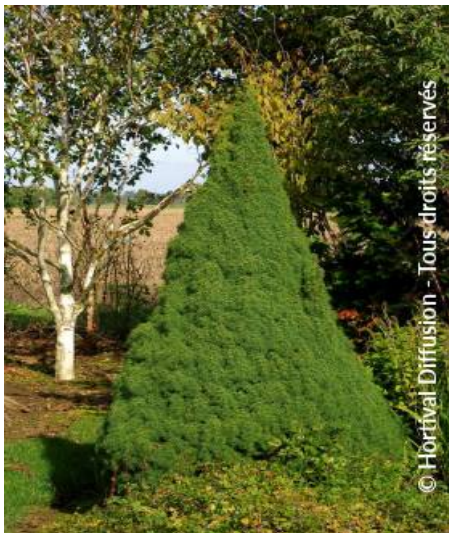









# PICEA glauca 'CONICA'

-  **Maintenance advice:** Plant in a well drained soil. Water regularly for the first 2 years.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Discovered in the mountains of Canada, near Lake Laggan, by Alfred Rehder and J.G. Jack in 1904.
-  **Use group:** Conifers
-  **Height at 10 years:** 2 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1 m
