-  **Maintenance advice:** In April, cut off any dead wood, the greying, older stems and wilted flowers. Keep the vigorous younger stems (with large buds). Water regularly in dry weather.

-  **Use group:** Heathland plants
-  **Height at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1 m
