-  **Maintenance advice:** In april, cut off any dead wood, the greying, older stems and wilted flowers. Keep the vigorous younger stems (with large buds). Water regularly in dry weather.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin : breeder Gaigné, St. Germain en Laye (FR) around 1944
-  **Use group:** Heathland plants
-  **Height at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Growth:** Medium

-  **Exposure:** Shade - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
