-  **Maintenance advice:** Azaleas appreciate cool soils. Water regularly in dry weather, lessen from mid August, to get a better flowering in the following spring.

-  **Use group:** Heathland plants
-  **Height at 10 years:** 1 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1 m
-  **Growth:** Slow
