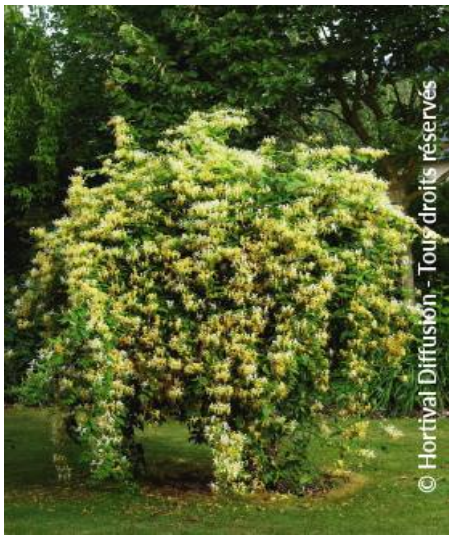


LONICERA similis var.delavayi

Delavay honeysuckle



Climbing honey-suckle, evergreen, scented flowers opening white turning to yellow.



Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, prune to the desired dimensions and cut off some old branches to rejuvenate, if necessary.



Botanical/Horticultural origin: China : introduced by the Abbott J-M. Delavay for Maurice de Vilmorin (FR) before 1896



Use group: Climbers
