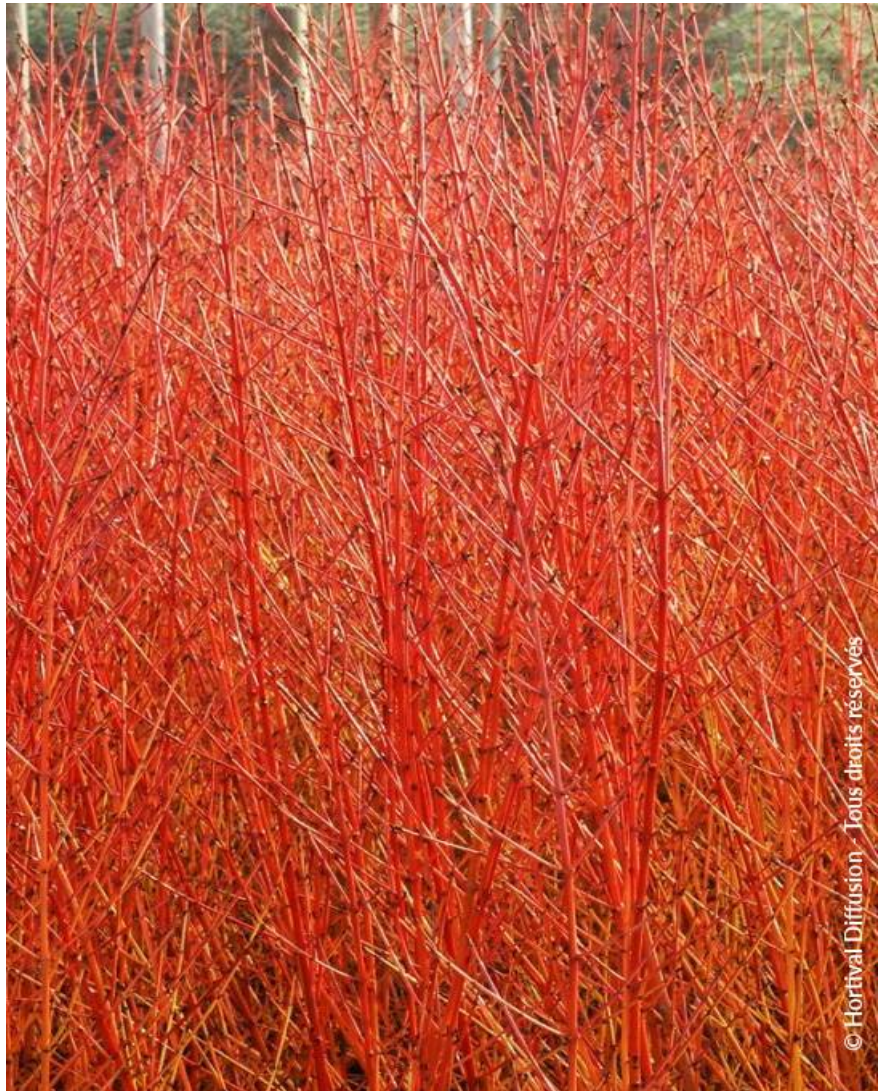
















CORNUS sanguinea 'MID WINTER FIRE'

Deciduous shrub, pale green leaves with yellow orange autumn colour. Splendid orange winter stems.

-  **Maintenance advice:** Remove any old, less colourful branches at the end of winter. Prune every 2-3 years to improve flowering.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Found in a garden by H. Venhorst (NL) around 1988
-  **Use group:** Shrubs
-  **Height at 10 years:** 3 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 2 m
-  **Growth:** Medium
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** bushy
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** White
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Free standing specimen, Border, Hedge
