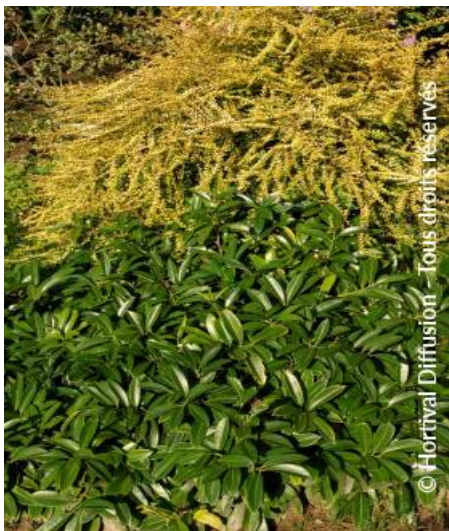
















# PRUNUS laurocerasus 'MOUNT VERNON'
