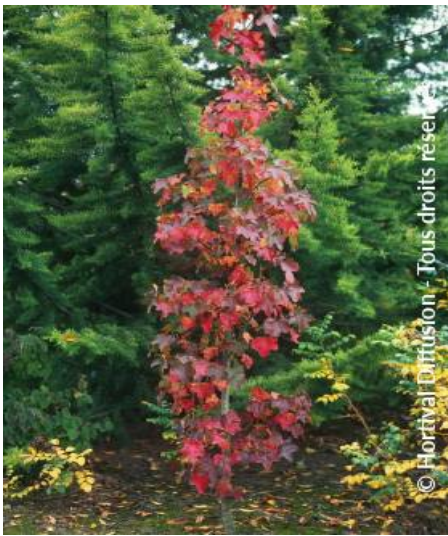
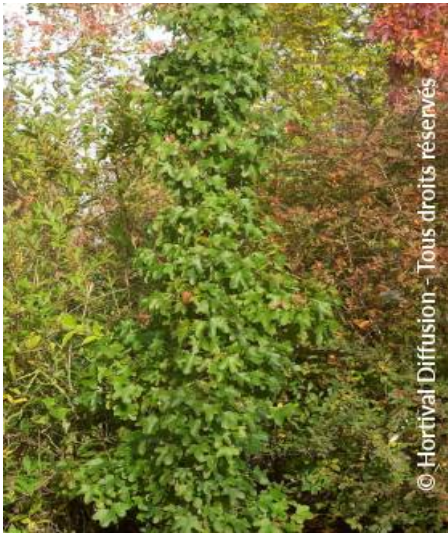







LIQUIDAMBAR styraciflua 'ROTUNDILOBA'
