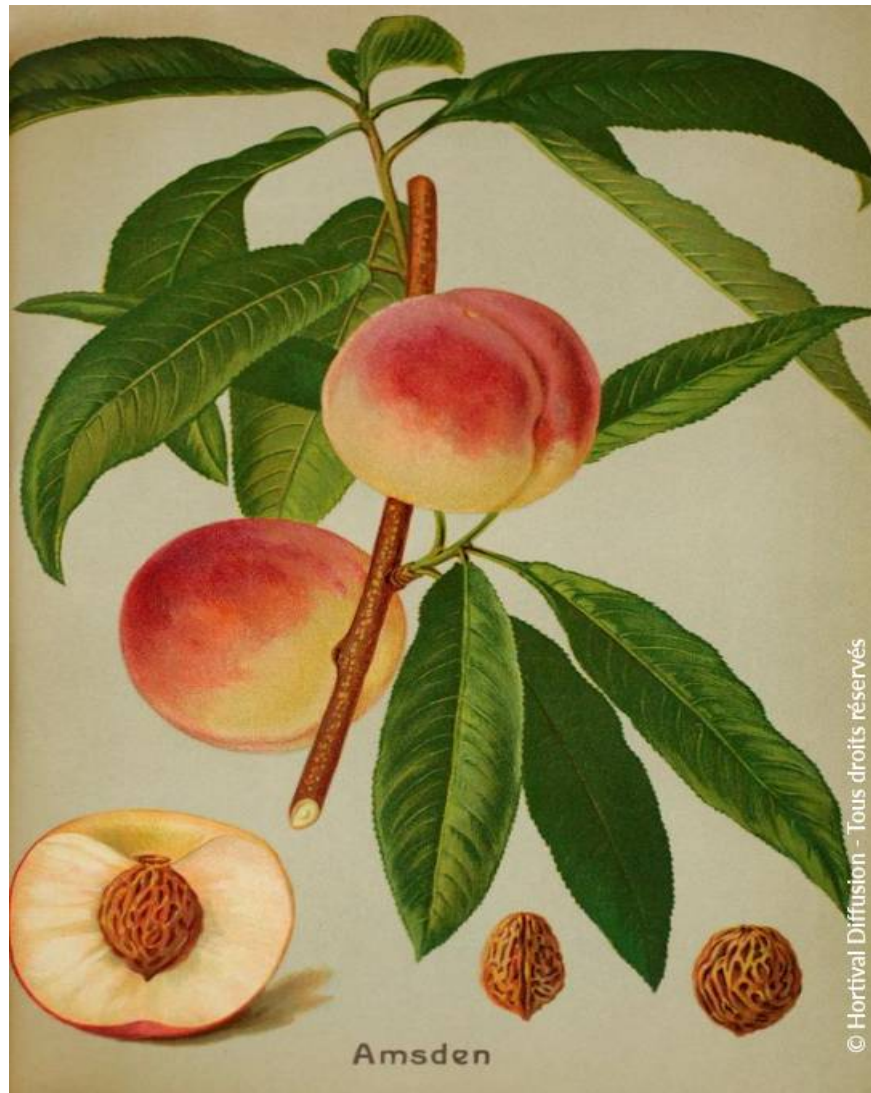
















# PRUNUS persica 'AMSDEN'

-  **Maintenance advice:** After flowering, find and cut down the non flowering branches , leaving just 2-3 buds. Shorten other less flowering branches, to just above a leaf bud, to rejuvenate.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin : breeder L.C. Amsden, Cartago, Missouri (US) around 1900
-  **Use group:** Fruit Trees
-  **Height at 10 years:** 4 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 3 m
-  **Growth:** Fast

-  **Exposure:** Full sun
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** tree like
