-  **Maintenance advice:** In April, cut off any dead wood, the older greying stems, the wilted flowers and keep the younger, more vigorous stems (bearing large buds). Water regularly in dry weather.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin : brought back from Japan by Corinne Mallet (FR) 1994
-  **Use group:** Heathland plants
-  **Height at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Growth:** Fast
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Shade - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** rounded, ball, globe
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** Purplish pink
