Japanese wisteria 'Domino'



Hardy deciduous climber. Pale blue flowers reliably produced while the plant is still young.

-  **Maintenance advice:** At the end of winter, Cut short, keeping 4-5 flower buds per branch (bigger and rounder than the leaf buds). In autumn, shorten, about 20cm, length of shoots
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin : breeder Koichiro Wada (Japan) before 1940
-  **Use group:** Climbers
-  **Height at 10 years:** 4 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 3 m
-  **Growth:** Fast
-  **Fragrance:** No
-  **Exposure:** Full sun
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** climbing
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** Lavender
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Climber, Tub/container, Free standing specimen
