-  **Maintenance advice:** Optional, after flowering. Can be shortened, if necessary. Shortening will encourage branches to keep growing so that the base stays well ramified. Otherwise, just lighten the plant and eliminate any dead wood.

-  **Use group:** Climbers
-  **Height at 10 years:** 6 m
