-  **Maintenance advice:** Remove the dead reeds at the end of winter. Water abundantly and regularly for the first 2 years.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin : sown by the United States National Arboretum, with seeds sent from Gérard Moudry, Baltimore
-  **Use group:** Bamboo and Grass
-  **Height at 10 years:** 1 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1 m
-  **Growth:** Fast
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** bush, spreading
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** Black
-  **Soil type:** Indifferent
-  **Uses:** Border, Tub/container, Rockery
