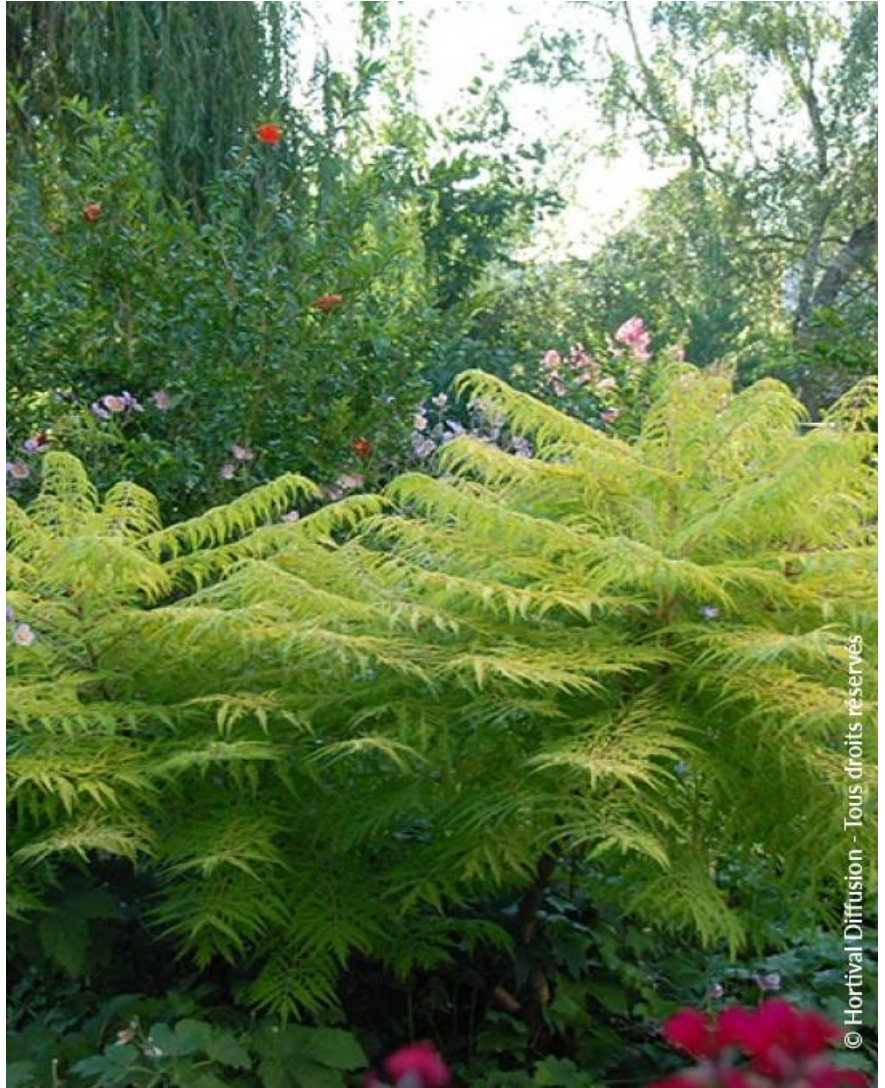

Maintenance advice: At the end of winter, cutting off any flower branches will encourage the appearance of fruit. Easily rejuvenated by cutting down to 15-20cm from the ground every 5 years, if wanted. Eliminate some of the suckering shoots, if necessary.
