Senecio/Brachyglottis 'Drysdale', Daisy Bush



-  **Maintenance advice:** In summer, eliminate the dried flowers if wanted. After flowering, trim shoots lightly to maintain compact. A more severe pruning is possible at the end of winter.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Horticultural origin : Hybrid of Dunedin, probably bred in New Zealand.
-  **Use group:** Mild Climate plants
-  **Height at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Growth:** Medium
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Evergreen
-  **Shape:** rounded, ball, globe
-  **Colour of leaves:** Silver grey
-  **Colour of flowers:** Yellow
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
-  **Uses:** Border, Rockery, Tub/container
