-  **Maintenance advice:** Will tolerate pruning after flowering. Water frequently and spray the leaves in summer when planted in pots and regularly, without excess, the rest of the year. Add some anti-chlorosis in the water if the leaves turn yellow.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** East Australia ; discovered in 1824.
-  **Use group:** Mild Climate plants
-  **Height at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 1,5 m
-  **Growth:** Medium
-  **Fragrance:** Yes

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Evergreen
-  **Shape:** bushy
-  **Colour of leaves:** Blue green
