-  **Maintenance advice:** Pruning is often unnecessary. Remove some of the diverging branches in winter, if necessary.
-  **Botanical/Horticultural origin:** Found in north Caucasia by Herman Geers (NL) before 2007
-  **Use group:** Trees
-  **Height at 10 years:** 8 m
-  **Width at 10 years:** 4 m
-  **Growth:** Medium
-  **Fragrance:** No

-  **Exposure:** Sun - Half shade
-  **Evergreen/Deciduous:** Deciduous
-  **Shape:** rigid, upright
-  **Colour of leaves:** Green
-  **Colour of flowers:** Red
-  **Soil type:** Cool to dry
