Foliage is green then dark purple in summer and autumn, with red flowers with white centres.

-  **Maintenance advice:** Trim a third in height at the end of winter. Eliminate wilted flowers in summer to encourage repeat flowering. Trimming is easy and non-restrictive and can be done even with shearers at the end of winter.
